



There is one work (file), and it is derived from another work (in this case, vi.exe version 1.0). In this case, the derivative work is created by another author, who added “the derivative portion” directly to vi.exe to create a new work (vim.exe version 1.0). That new work acts like an original work (i.e., a software application), but is in fact a derivative work. Remember, the scope of the copyright for the derivative work extends only to the derivative portion. The author of vi.exe still retains his copyright to that portion of the derivative work.
